Maîtresse



Allen Jones (*1937) is one of the most significant British pop-artists on the international stage who participated in the 1960s in the development of this new attitude to figuration. The exhibition “Maîtresse” focuses thematically on the 1976 produced movie “Maîtresse. She will open your eyes” by the French film director and producer Barbet Schroeder staging as main actors Gérard Depardieu and Bulle Ogier. The costumes were designed by Karl Lagerfeld and it was Allen Jones who created the film poster that displays an alluring brunette dominatrix suited in varnish holding a leather whip—portraying a subculture generating creative force through masochism. In manifold realization and by playing with poses, colors and space the motif of “Maîtresse” developed to a discrete series of works in his

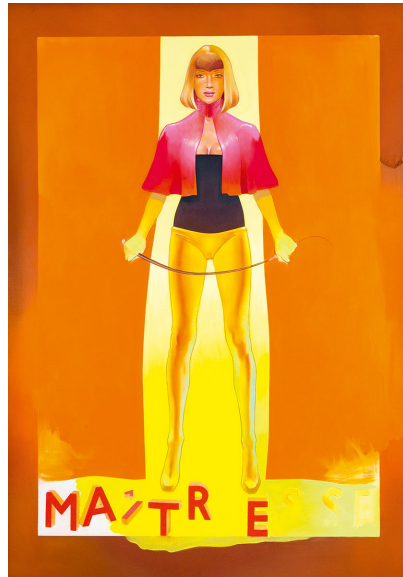


oeuvre that in the main focuses on the display of gender roles, eroticism and fetish. The show comprises large-sized paintings, drawings, study sheets, a newly realized edition of silkscreens original archive material. The exhibition can be amended with thematically related works.

With up to 7 paintings, 4 silkscreens, further paintings, drawings, study sheets, graphics as well as archive material

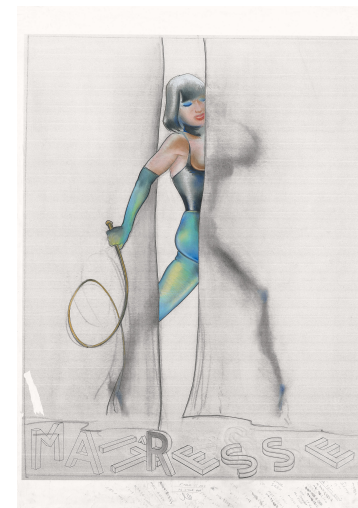
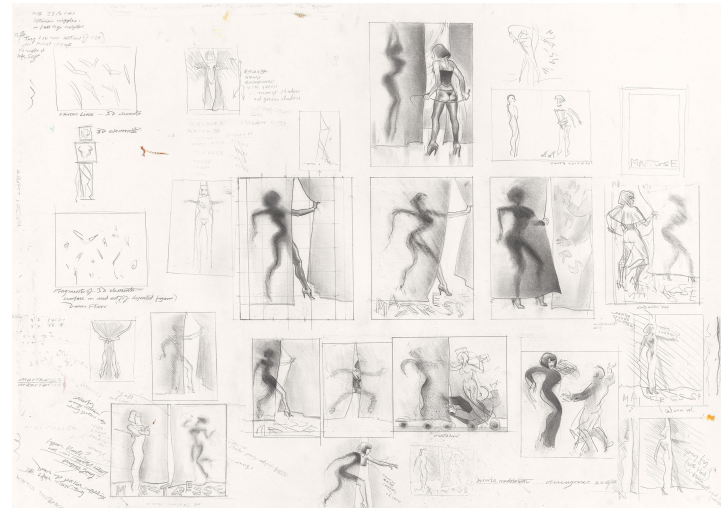
